

Sean Hind's dream itinerary takes us to Gonarezhou, Zimbabwe's second largest national park and known as "the place of elephants". It is, in fact, home to incredible varied landscapes, including the iconic Chilojo Cliffs, over 11,500 pachyderms, 450 species of birds, 89 large mammal species, 61 small mammals, over 50 fish species, 116 identified reptile species and 34 amphibian species.

Sean, whose business operates as Safaris I Can See, (and we would add Hear and Feel!) works with two different camp locations in a wonderfully wild 7-night Gonarezhou itinerary that includes 3 Nights at Mahove Bush Camp and 4 Nights at Chilojo Bush Camp with one of these nights spent out fly camping.



What a Typical Day looks like

Early morning wake up call
Tea and coffee with rusks, cereal/porridge


Head out at sunrise, either by vehicle or on foot depending on what animal activity has been happening in the area. We normally spend the morning activity on foot or at least part of it, tracking animals and learning about the bush, as well as just listening to the sounds of nature. We will have a tea basket and a cooler box in the vehicle for refreshments after the walk.

Then we head back to camp after the morning activity for brunch or early lunch and spend mid day in camp relaxing.

The afternoon starts with tea and cake and then we head out on the vehicle, normally to a pan or down to the river – and finish up the day with sundowners.

The evening is spent telling stories around the campfire and enjoying the magnificent African skies.

3 Nights Mahove Bush Camp 4 Nights Chilojo Bush Camp (1 of these nights Fly Camping)
